

The following disclosure is intended to provide supply chain information requested by the State of California in connection with concerns about human trafficking and slavery under the California Transparency in Supply Chains Act of 2010.

National Presto Industries, Inc. (the "Company") deals with a handful of trusted sources in foreign countries all of which are visited regularly either by Company employees or by its long-time and respected agent. The Company's contract with each supplier provides that forced labor will not be tolerated and requires that the supplier maintain employment on a voluntary basis. The contracts also state that any product manufactured by the use of forced labor will be rejected. The Company will cease business with a supplier if the Company becomes aware that such supplier has violated the applicable laws against slavery and/or human trafficking.

The Company is in the process of instituting an annual certification process under which each foreign supplier with whom it deals will be requested to provide (and also request that the supplier secure from its suppliers) affirmative certifications that the supplier is not engaging in either human trafficking or slavery. The Company does not intend to institute formal audits, training, verifications, or other formal internal accountability standards and procedures beyond the use of its contracts and this certification process.
